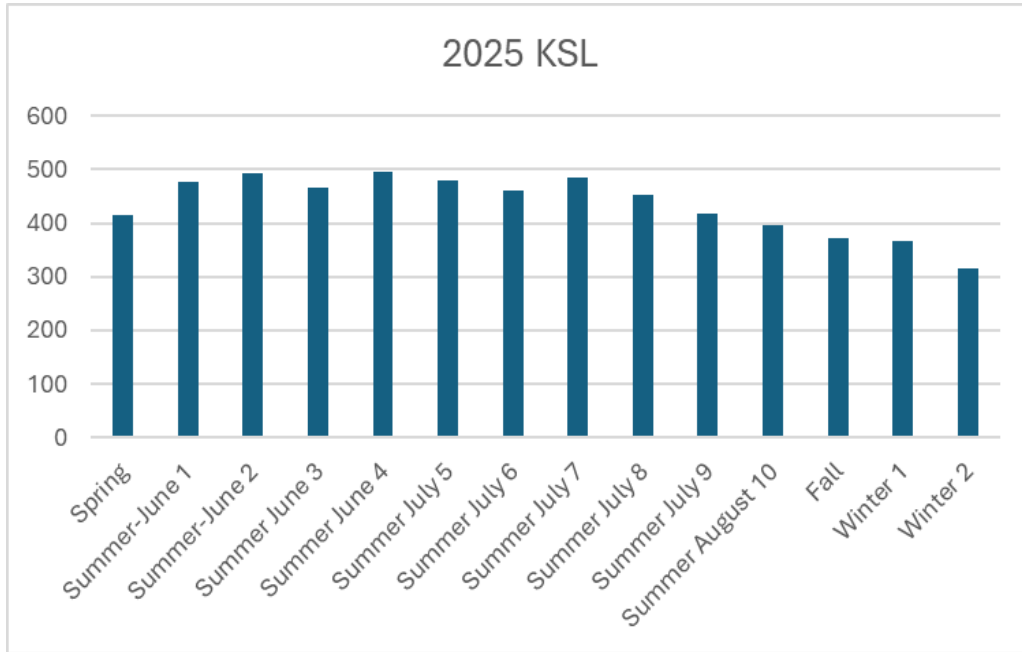

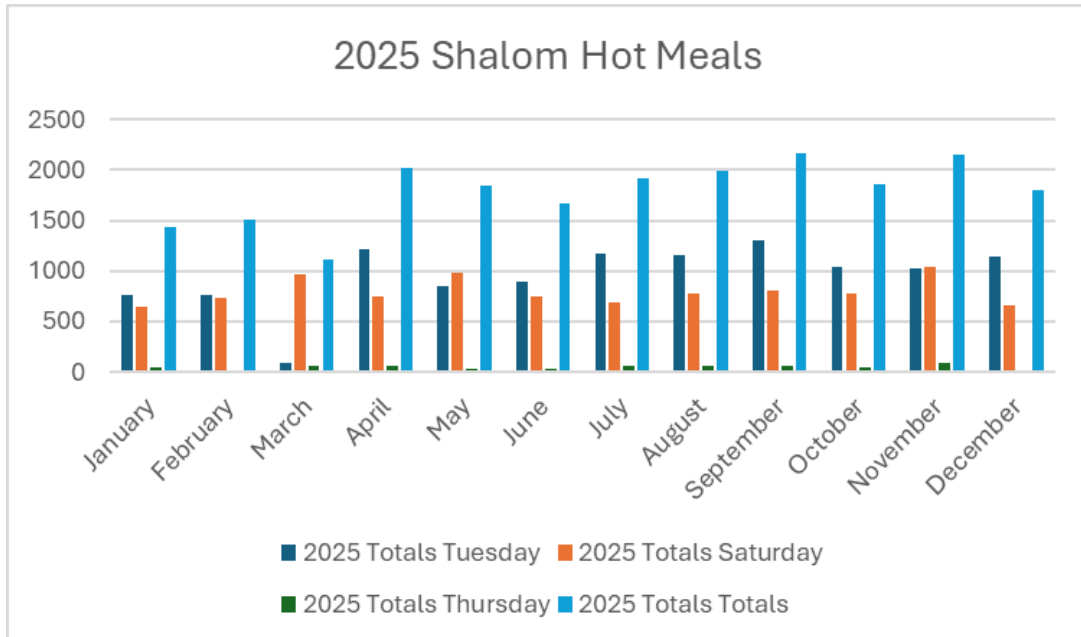

60,920 Total Meals served in 2025**

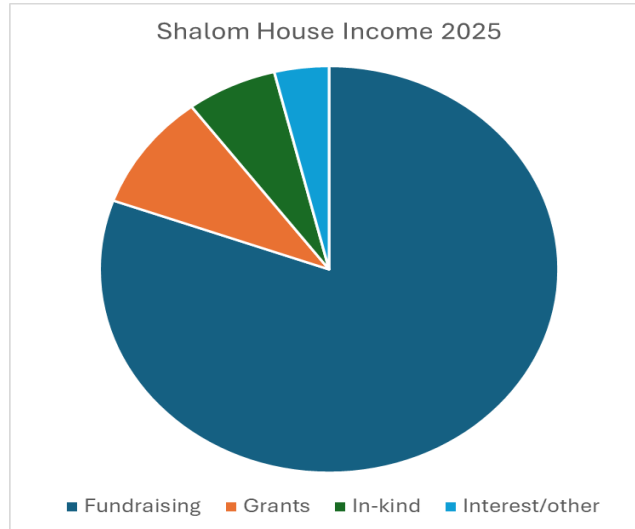
Shalom House Hot Meals Served



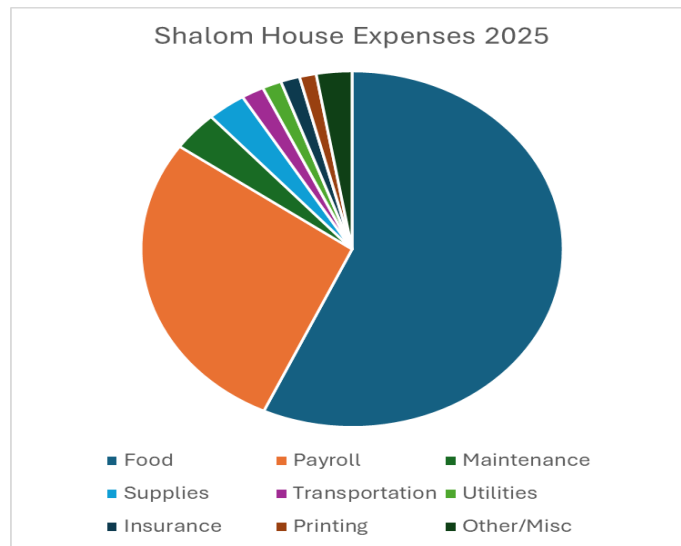

The Shalom House staff are absolutely incredible, they drive the engine and always deliver with enthusiasm. Our board is highly focused on the Shalom Community and also keeps its eyes on the horizon as the needs continue to grow.

Shalom House saw an increase in need across both programs (Kid's Sack Lunch and Hot Meals) and met that need directly. We have launched a third food program named "Backpack Meals." This program gives kids meals for the weekends, and these are placed in a discreet backpack that allows them to take these home. This program is currently rolled out in 4 Boone County Schools, and our team hopes to be in 6 or 7 by year's end.

2026 Needs for the Shalom House Programs

- \$300 will fund one Tuesday or Saturday meal.
- Teams of 6-8 volunteers needed per day to serve Shalom hot meals.
